This puppy has been vet checked by Didsbury Veterinary Clinic and found to be in perfect health. A refund may not be offered if the puppy has been found to have contracted a contagious illness, due to lack of quarantine or proper immunizations, or injured in the adopters care. We will still offer a refund beyond a months time, but it will depend on the age and condition of the puppy, so the refund offered will be on a case by case basis following an assessment.

We offer a two year genetic warranty covering any genetic condition projected to dramatically decrease the dog's life expectancy, provided our vet agrees with the genetic nature and the severity of the diagnosis. We will not reimburse/cover treatment or diagnostic costs and may require that the dog be examined by our vet in order to activate the warranty, at the owner's expense. A puppy of equal value will be offered that can be claimed at any time by the adopter, provided we are still breeding and producing litters. There is no need to return the original dog. Baby Barks genetic health warrantee does not cover any bite abnormalities or teeth issues. Please contact us if you experience health concerns with your dog as we endeavor to breed the healthiest dogs possible. If adopters keep us updated with major health changes in their pets, we are better able to adjust our breeding program accordingly to reduce these occurrences.
